## Claiming Records

The onus is on the **Archer** to notify the EMAS Records Officer of any claims they wish to make.

A listing of all records is held on the EMAS website: [www.emasarchery.co.uk](http://www.emasarchery.co.uk)

If in doubt, claim it.

Postal Rounds are not eligible for record purposes

**All claims must reach the EMAS Records Officer within 3 months of being shot.**

Approved claims for new records will only be posted on the website once the three month claiming period has expired.

Please complete all sections of the claim form & attach any supporting documents - it is not the responsibility of the records officer to locate & print off results sheets, please send them as attachments to your email or in hard copy by post

## Team records

All team records must be shot at open tournaments and above. Claims must be accompanied by an official results sheet. [See record list - we had a new claim in 2010. The first in 9 years.](#)

## Individual Records

Rounds marked **R/S** must be shot at **Record Status Tournaments**.

Claims for rounds shot in competition must include the official results sheet.

The results sheet must clearly state that the event did have 'record status'.

Rounds marked **Club** can be shot at any tournament or club target day where GNAS rules of shooting are observed. At a club target day the round must have been scored and witnessed by another archer, senior or junior, shooting the round with the claimant. The claim must include the original scoresheet or photocopy and be endorsed by a club officer as follows:-  
*"shot on a club target day under GNAS rules of shooting and entered in the club records book"*  
signed by club officer, the witnessing archer and the archer claiming the record.

## 12 Dozen Metric Rounds and distance record claims

Please use the multiple claim form where 'whole round' and distance claims are being submitted for the same event.

All **Bare bow** records must be shot at Record Status shoots and the bows must comply with GNAS/ FITA Field bare bow rules. (i.e. no sight block, no clicker, no stabilisers)

Junior longbow & bare bow type records are in U/18 only, i.e. one age group.

The junior records for recurve & compound bow types are in age groups.

Therefore in these categories please be aware of the age group rounds i.e.:- a Boy u/18 can't claim a Bristol 2 etc.

In the case of under 9 Recurves records are kept, but EMAS does not encourage juniors aged under 9 to shoot 12 dozen rounds. It is entirely up to the archer & their parents.

Double Rounds In most cases 'Where two or more rounds are shot on one day in succession at the same venue, only the first round will be accepted for a single record, irrespective of bowstyle'. GNAS rules 308 & 705 apply.
