Rounds available are: **Seniors** – Record Status Long National in the morning followed by a Non Record Status National in the afternoon or a Record Status National in the morning followed by a Non Record Status National in the afternoon.

Juniors – a Record Status National Round appropriate to age in the morning followed by the same Non Record Status round in the afternoon. (Please see back page for Rounds according to age).

Record Status Shoots are liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples **must** comply: Refusal will be treated as a positive result. The entry form for Juniors **MUST** be signed by a **Parent or Guardian** to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached.

G.N.A.S. Dress Code Rule 307 will apply all day.

All rounds will be shot to G.N.A.S. Rules 304. All ends will consist of 2 x 3 Arrows.

Sherwood Archers reserve the right to move juniors up to the next available distance if necessary.

Medals will be given for all rounds shot including the Double round (Long National + National as well as the Double National) for Ladies, Gentlemen & Juniors shooting Recurve, Compound, Longbow & Barebow (G.N.A.S. Rule 204).

There is a Team award for the Double National Round (Team of 3 consisting of 1 Recurve, 1 Compound & 1 Longbow from the same club)

Refreshments and Raffle will be on sale through out the day.

G.N.A.S cards must be shown on the day.

Anyone wishing to shoot Pure Carbon Arrow shafts must notify the Tournament Organiser on the day of the shoot.

Results will be posted for 5 minutes before the presentation, after which no alterations will be made
