A qualifying tournament for WA Target Awards

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All archers must be affiliated to Archery GB or a WA Member Association; they will be asked to produce their membership cards when signing in.
2. Awards will be made to all classes, subject to entry.
3. Archers should arrive in time for kit inspection which will commence 20 minutes before assembly.
4. Sessions B & C will not start before their specified times
5. Two practice ends will be shot at the start of each WA 18 round.
6. WA vertical triple faces will be used for compound archers. Other archers will use a single spot face, although they may request a vertical triple face.
7. Archery GB dress regulations as shown in Archery GB Rule 307 will apply. In addition, soft soled shoes must be worn.
8. Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors' entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached.
9. Light refreshments will be available.
10. Smoking and vaping are not permitted on the College site, including the car parks.
11. Anyone wishing to take photographs during the tournament must register their details with the tournament organisers on arrival. Please notify the organisers if you have concerns about your child/young person being photographed or you notice any unauthorised photography.
12. The organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or personal possessions.
13. Target and results lists will be sent in .pdf format to those providing an e-mail address. If necessary, hard copies will be sent to those providing a stamped, self-addressed envelope (23cm x 16cm minimum) with their entry.
14. No refunds can be made after the closing date.
