The tournament will be run in accordance with the Government legislation and Archery GB guidance in place at the date of the event.

Pre attendance symptom check:

All competitors, officials, volunteers and parents/guardians must undergo a self-assessment for any COVID-19 symptoms. No-one should leave home to attend this competition if they, or someone they live with, have symptoms of COVID-19 currently recognised as any of the following:

- *A high temperature*
- *A new, continuous cough*
- *A loss of, or change to, their sense of smell or taste*

Entries: There will be a maximum of 12 bosses/48 archers. Due to the limited number of places, we will give priority to maximising the number of archers shooting on every boss. We will confirm successful entries, and the target list as soon as possible after the closing date and at least three days before the event.

Entry fee: Seniors £14.00, under 18 £7.00. BACS payments to Wilford Bowmen, 30-96-18, 65023068, please include your initial and surname in the reference.

Ages and rounds: WA 1440 (Gents), WA 1440 (Ladies), Metrics 1-5
Younger archers may shoot higher rounds.

Bosses: Layered foam bosses will be used. At the two shorter distances all compound and recurve archers will shoot ends of six arrows at individual six ring 80cm target faces. At the two shorter distances barebow, longbow and archers shooting the junior rounds will shoot ends of six arrows at 80cm ten ring target faces.

Closing date: 17th May or when full.

Awards: subject to entry and will distributed after the event.

Target List: A provisional target list and associated pre-event delivery information will be available at www.wilfordbowmen.wordpress.com at least three days before the event and will also be distributed by email.

Notes:

- Please bring your own food and drink.

- Each archer has been allocated a 2 metre square for a tent and equipment. **Please do not bring any gazebos or large tents.**
- All archers under 18 must be accompanied by ONE Parent, Guardian or Carer for the duration of the shoot, who will be expected to remain in the archer's tent.
- Apart from the above, only competitors, officials and work party are allowed on the competition venue.
- World Record Status has been granted for this event. Archery GB rule 307 will apply. Record Status tournaments are liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. It is a requirement of Record Status events that parents/guardians of juniors entering must sign the entry form to give consent for drug testing.
- GDPR – When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with NHS Track and Trace, tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow Style, Date of Birth/Age category, Email, Address, Phone Number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
- In accordance with Archery GB Child Protection policy anyone wishing to take photographs or image recording at this event must complete the Register of Photographers, before doing so.
- Archery GB cards or e-cards are to be shown on arrival, competitors may only shoot with proof of membership.
- Wilford Bowmen (Nottingham), Greasley Castle Archers will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to competitors' goods or equipment.
